Notification of Failure to File
The February 10, 2026 Lobbyist Employment and Expenditure
Reports

According to the Secretary of State's Office, you have failed to file Lobbyist Employment and Expenditure Reports due **February 10, 2026** (covering the period of January 2026) as required by K.S.A. 46-268 for **all the above identified lobbying clients**. Such reports must be completed and filed within five (5) days of the date of receipt of this notice to avoid complaints being filed.

Failure to file the reports **within two days** will result in the assessment of civil penalties. As provided by K.S.A. 46-280, you have until **February 14, 2026**, to comply with the reporting requirements before civil penalties are imposed. The automatically imposed civil penalty is \$100 for the first day and \$50 per day thereafter for each day the required report remains unfiled. No civil penalty shall exceed \$1,000. **A civil penalty will be individually assessed for each above identified lobbying client.** Also, there are criminal penalties for intentionally failing to file. **It is unlawful to lobby when a current report has not been filed or is past due.** Unlawful lobbying is a class B misdemeanor.
